





MONTGOMERY COUNTY UPGRADES

OBJECTIVE

Provide a million gallons/day to EJ Water's western side of their distrubution system to serve the large, rapid membership growth, along with a recent partnership bringing on a community that serves over 2,500 population and large agricultural membership along with three wholesalers.

BACKGROUND

EJ Water has experienced unprecedented growth with over 1,600 new sign-ups in the system since the water system was started and the recent acquisition of Montgomery County Water. The line loops and transmission main are needed to provide a more reliable supply to the residents and municipalities in this portion of EJ's service area. This project consists of approximately 34 miles of watermain, two new water towers, pump station, and appurtenances.

CHALLENGE

Funding is the main challenge, though EJ Water will have matching funds available if able to receive grants for capital improvements.


